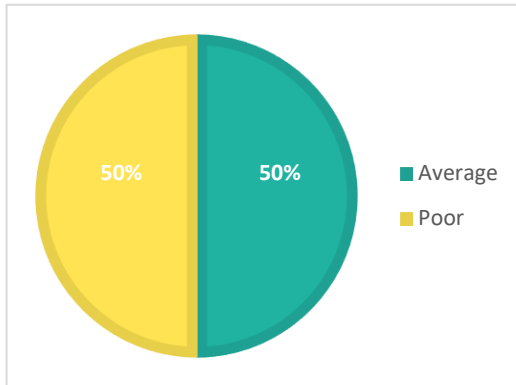



How well do you think the Central Florida transportation system serves the needs of its residents and visitors?

1 **ADD TRANSIT**


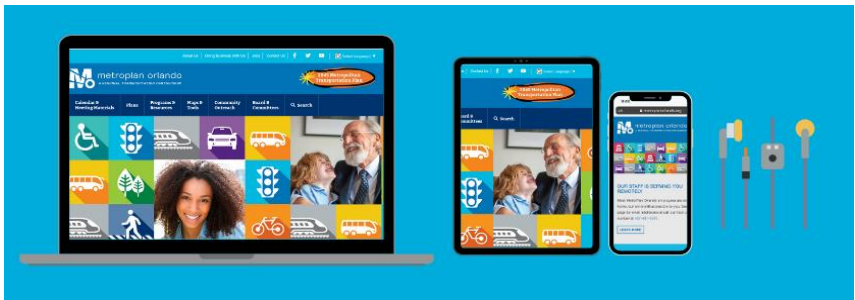
